503 – ADMISSION OF EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Introduction

While the primary mandate of Kelowna Christian School is to provide instruction for students who are residing with their parents/guardians in Kelowna, instruction may be provided on a reciprocal basis to students participating in school recognized student exchange programs.

The school recognizes the value of student exchange programs as a way to gain insights into the attitudes, beliefs and lifestyles of other cultures. Student exchanges also increase global and multicultural understanding and help to develop bridges to people around the world.

Policy 503

Upon meeting the following criteria, exchange students will be permitted to attend classes at Kelowna Christian School on a non-fee paying basis, according to the time parameters of their exchange program.

Criteria

1. Students will be part of a Kelowna Christian School recognized program, where the exchange is on a one in/one out format.
2. Students will have documentation proving their legal ability to reside in Canada for the duration of the program.
3. Students will comply with the KCS Student Code of Conduct.
4. If the conditions of the Exchange Program have not been upheld by the student, the school will make arrangements, at the expense of the exchange student's family, to return the student to his/her home.
5. The school will determine the accommodation arrangement for each student.
6. Students will have international medical insurance, proof of which will be submitted to the school and a copy of which will be given to the host family at the beginning of the stay.
7. The school will not be responsible for travel arrangements or medical expenses.
