

Policy 415 – Discrimination, Harassment and Bullying Protection Policy

The safety and wellbeing of children is of paramount consideration. Children deserve to be protected from abuse, neglect, bullying, harm or threat of harm. Therefore, we will ensure that children attending our school will experience a learning environment that enables every child to feel safe, accepted and respected regardless of their race, culture, sexual orientation or gender identity/expression.

Examples of unacceptable behaviour include: bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, intimidation, and threatening or violent behaviours.

Acceptable behaviours are those which ensure students feel safe and included.

Where a student or other person reports breaches of this policy, the school will take reasonable steps to try and ensure their protection from retaliation.

Consequences for unacceptable behaviour will follow the school's policies as outlined in our student handbooks and discipline policies. These policies will be applied in a way that takes account of the student's age, maturity and special needs, if any.
